## Spring Meeting warning !

**We're holding our spring meeting at HMS Belfast on the Thames in central London, on May 21st at 10.15 for 10.45. Book the date in your diary now!**

### Programme 2009

It is our intention to provide the following member benefits in 2009:

- May: Spring meeting as above – the theme for the meeting will be “back to basics” with topics such as basic UDIs, indexes, database querying for reporting. It will be a good opportunity for members to bring their new colleagues along. The full programme is still under discussion and may change.
- May: Launch of a DUG-branded ‘posting spreadsheet’ for you to create journals in Excel and post them directly to Dream using the External DLL. This will be made available free of charge to all members after the May meeting.
- May: Sneak preview of another DUG-branded software utility. This one will be a tool to allow you to download and upload budget data to and from Excel. It will only work with Dream 3.1 onwards where budgets can be posted to Dream using the External DLL. It will allow various posting options which the Dream user interface doesn't use. You'll be able to keep your budget in Excel, and then upload it easily to Dream, in full or in part.
- June: Release of the above Budget Maintenance tool. This will be downloadable, but a license key will be required, and you'll only get a licence key by coming to the May meeting !
- October: Possible meeting of special interest groups for Education sector.
- November: Two day meeting with special interest groups. One day will be dedicated to our normal meeting with plenary sessions from us and from members, plus sessions by vendors. The second day will be devoted to small group sessions on topics such as UDI design, coding for the external DLL, integration, best practice, year-end, or whatever there is demand for in the run-up to the meeting.

The November meeting, like last year's, will offer some entertainment as well as work topics!

We also intend to seek other software where the vendor may be prepared to offer a DUG-branded version of the software at discounted rates to members.

### Object

The objective of the DREAM User Group is to provide services to Member organisations using the DREAM accounting system produced by CODA plc. The User Group will provide information and hold meetings, and will make collective representations to CODA and others for the general benefit of the Members.
